At The Corner London City, we recognise the critical importance of environmental sustainability and are committed to minimising our environmental impact and promoting a greener future. Our environmental policy outlines our dedication to environmental protection, conservation, and responsible practices to ensure a more sustainable business model. This policy applies to all aspects of our operations.

Energy Efficiency and Conservation: We will continuously strive to improve energy efficiency throughout our premises by employing energy-efficient technologies, such as LED lighting, and optimising our lighting systems. Additionally, we are proud to run our hotel on East London sunshine through the installation of solar panels on the roof, making us more self-sufficient and reducing our reliance on traditional energy sources. Corridor lights are equipped with light-saving sensory controls to optimise energy usage.

Waste Management: Our goal is to reduce, reuse, and recycle waste generated at The Corner London City. We have implemented waste separation practices and encourage the use of recyclable materials. Comprehensive recycling bins will be conveniently placed throughout the hotel to ensure proper disposal and recycling of plastic, paper, and glass waste. Additionally, we will work to recycle used cooking oil and have glass crushers for responsible glass waste management.

Water Conservation: We are committed to conserving water resources and have implemented water-saving measures in our operations. This includes the use of Hansgrohe Airdrop shower heads in the bathrooms, which mix air with water, reducing water consumption by 25% per minute without affecting the shower's water pressure. We also fix leaks promptly, install water-efficient fixtures, and educate staff and guests about responsible water usage.

Sustainable Sourcing: Wherever possible, we prioritise the procurement of goods and services from local and sustainable sources. This includes partnering with ethical and sustainable providers, stocking products like the delicious SeaChange Wine in our bar, and using locally sourced ingredients in our kitchen.

Carbon Footprint Reduction: We work diligently to reduce our carbon footprint by setting emission reduction targets, implementing carbon offsetting initiatives, and continuously evaluating our supply chain, energy consumption, and waste management practices.

Non-Toxic Cleaning Products: We prioritise the use of non-toxic cleaning products to minimise harm to the environment and maintain a healthy space for both guests and staff.

Plastic-Free Initiatives: Bottled filtered water is available in the rooms and restaurant, eliminating the use of plastic throughout the hotel. We also offer communal tea and coffee stations on each floor to save energy and reduce waste.

Guest Incentives for Green Efforts: Guests staying multiple nights who voluntarily choose not to have their rooms cleaned will receive a drink voucher to spend at the bar as a token of appreciation for their contribution to our green efforts.

Compliance and Regulations: We are committed to complying with all relevant environmental laws and regulations, as well as voluntary industry standards that align with our sustainability goals.
